As you may be aware, the people of Ethiopia have been facing challenging times due to a conflict. This conflict has had devastating consequences, most notably the looting and destruction of numerous hospitals in multiple regions of Ethiopia. Oxygen tanks have been pulled out, various equipment's like ultrasound machines have been broken, and medications and vaccines have been spilled and rendered useless. As a result, sick and vulnerable patients, and those most in need of medical attention, are suffering. Innocent victims who are not involved with the conflict continue to be in dire need of medical assistance. Due to the lack of resources, those in need of emergent medical attention are not able to get the care they need, and medications and treatments for patients with long-standing health problems such as tuberculosis, diabetes, HIV/AIDS infection have been discontinued. It is disheartening that these innocent victims are the most impacted by the current conflict, though they have nothing do with the war or the politics.

In order to raise awareness for those innocent victims in need of medical attention, Doctors For Ethiopia has created a platform for the mobilization of medical supplies. We are working with Yetena Weg, a registered organization with a volunteer network of healthcare professionals working to improve healthcare information in Ethiopia, to mobilize these resources. However, medications have been deemed in emergent need by the Ethiopian Ministry of Health.
